MEDIA RELEASE

News items for the period between August 8th and August 14th, 2011

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 75 occurrences during the seven day period ending August 14th, 2011. This included 22 criminal occurrences, 2 motor vehicle collisions, 7 calls to 911 for assistance. There were several charges under the Highway Traffic Act, one charge under the Liquor Licence Act and one By-law charge in relation to excessive noise.

August 8th, 2011

On August 8th, 2011 officers of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a report of a break and enter of a garage at a Stone Street residence. Items taken included a Makita Drill and Driver combo set, ½” Ridgid hammer drill, a ½” Dewalt hammer drill, a 32” flat screen TV and a 40 piece socket set. Anyone with information is asked to contact Gananoque Police Service or Crimestoppers.

August 8th, 2011

On August 8, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service responded to a call to check on the welfare of a male who is on release conditions due to a previous occurrence. An investigation revealed the male was in violation of those conditions. The male was located, arrested and charged with failing to comply with his release conditions. Male was held for a show cause bail hearing and a thirty day mental health assessment.

August 9th, 2011

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a noise complaint at a King Street residence. Officers attended and found the loud music to be excessive. Officers charged the resident with excessive noise under the Bylaw.

August 11th, 2011

Gananoque Police Service received a call for assistance by Kingston Ambulance Dispatch. Ambulance attendants required assistance with a 20 year old female who had been drinking and was in possession of a knife, threatening to harm herself. Officers attended with ambulance attendants and female was transported to Kingston General Hospital for treatment.

August 12th, 2011

On August 12, 2011 officers of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a call of a break and enter of a boat house at a Stone Street South residence. A kayak, a 14' boat and a gas can were taken. The boat is believed to have been located, pending identification from the owner. The missing kayak is a blue and white Pelican brand kayak, approx 10 to 12 feet in length. August 12th, 2011

On August 12, 2011 officers of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a 911 call at a local business. A dispute between a male and staff resulted in a window being broken. As a result of an investigation a 21 year old male was arrested and charged with breach of undertaking, utter threat and mischief under \$5000. He was released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking before an officer in charge to appear in court at a later date.

August 13th, 2011

On August 13th, 2011 officers responded to a 911 call of a domestic dispute/male out of control at a King Street residence. Male had caused damage to the residence during the dispute. Male fled the scene prior to being arrested. Charges are pending against the male and a warrant is being sought for his arrest.

August 14th, 2011

Officers responded to a King Street residence after receiving a request for assistance from ambulance dispatch regarding a female who had overdosed on prescription medication. Female was transported to Kingston General Hospital by ambulance for assessment.
