Public Notice: Counterfeit Canadian Twenty Dollar Bills

(Gananoque) The Gananoque Police Service is reminding the public and businesses to be vigilant in detecting counterfeit money. On January 24, 2012, a 22 years old male was arrested and charged with 3 counts of uttering counterfeit money and two counts of fraud under \$5000.00. The accused had passed counterfeit twenty dollar Canadian bills (\$20.00) at three local businesses and is known to have frequented the Town of Prescott, City of Brockville and Town of Gananoque.

Prevention and detection are essential in the fight against counterfeiting. Police are encouraging consumers, cash handlers, and retailers to familiarize themselves with the security features on bank notes to protect themselves and keep counterfeits out of circulation.
