# MEDIA RELEASE

## News items for the period between November 28<sup>th</sup> and December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2011

---

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 35 occurrences during the seven day period ending December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2011. This included 15 criminal occurrences and 4 calls to 911 for assistance. Officers issued 5 Provincial Offence Notices and a three day driver's licence suspension.

### November 28th, 2011

On November 28<sup>th</sup> 2011 Officers received a call regarding an unwanted male in a Brock Street residence. As a result of an investigation a 48 year old male was issued a trespass notice to not attend the residence. No charges were laid.

### November 30th, 2011

On November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service received a report of a stolen vehicle from a King Street residence. Vehicle is described as a black 1998 Dodge Ram 4x4 taken in the overnight hours of November 29<sup>th</sup>. Anyone with information is asked to contact Gananoque Police Service or Crimestoppers.

### November 30th, 2011

On November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011 an officer responded to a Stone Street business in regards to a suspicious male and possible theft. Male was observed stealing spray paint from the business and later spray painting his vehicle in the business parking lot. The investigation is ongoing.

### November 30th, 2011

On November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011 the Gananoque Police responded to a concern for well being call at a King Street address. As a result an 80 year old female was apprehended under the Mental Health Act and transported to Brockville General Hospital for assessment.

### December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011

On December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011 Officers responded to a King Street business regarding a disturbance involving a patron. As a result of an investigation a 58 year old male was issued a trespass notice to not attend the business. No charges were laid.

## **December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011**

On December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011 Officers while conducting radar enforcement on Charles Street, conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for speeding. As a result of the traffic stop the male driver was charged under the Highway Traffic Act for speeding and failing to produce drivers licence. As a result of further investigation the 17 year old male driver was also arrested and charged with Failing to Comply with his Undertaking. Male was released to his parents on a promise to Appear and Undertaking to appear in court at a later date.
