MEDIA RELEASE

News items for the period between January 23rd and January 29th, 2012

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 36 occurrences during the seven day period ending January 29th, 2012. This included 7 criminal occurrences, 4 calls to 911 for assistance and 1 apprehension under the Mental Health Act.

January 23rd, 2012

On January 23rd, 2012 Police received a complaint of counterfeit money being received by businesses around town. An investigation resulted in the identification and arrest of a 22 year old male who was subsequently charged with three counts of uttering counterfeit currency along with one count of fraud under \$5000. The male was released to answer to the charges at a later court date.

January 25th, 2012

On January 25th, 2012 Police were called to attend at a King Street West residence in regards to a domestic disturbance complaint. Further investigation resulted in a 28 year old female being arrested for breach of the peace and subsequently released unconditionally later in that day.

January 26th, 2012

On January 26th, 2012 Police received a call regarding a suicidal female. As a result police attended and determined that grounds existed to apprehend the female under the Mental Health Act. The female was transported by police to hospital for further assessment.

January 27th, 2012

On January 27th, 2012 Police responded to a Hickory Street address in regards to a complaint of a male causing a disturbance in the area. A search of the area revealed that the male had fled prior to police arrival. Police are reminding the public to contact police should they observe any suspicious persons in their area.

January 27th, 2012

On January 27th, 2012 Police received a complaint regarding the theft of a large amount of copper wire from a local business which occurred between December 15th, 2011 and January 27th 2012. Police are requesting anyone with any knowledge about this crime to contact police or Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-8477. Information that is provided is confidential and you will not be required to identify yourself. Crime Stoppers pays a monetary reward for information that leads to an arrest of a suspect.

January 27th, 2012

On January 27th, 2012 Police responded to a youth home in the area in regards to a threatening complaint. Police attended and an investigation resulted in the arrest of a youth for uttering threats and failing to comply with the conditions of a previous release. The youth was held in custody pending a bail hearing.

January 27th, 2012

On January 27th, 2012 Police were called to attend at a King Street business in regards to an assault complaint. Upon arriving on scene further investigation revealed that the suspect had fled the scene prior to police arrival. With assistance from the public, police were able to identify the suspect who was contacted by police and subsequently turned himself in to police custody to deal with the outstanding charge. The suspect was arrested and charged with one count of assault and released to deal with the charge at a later court date. The Gananoque Police would like to take this opportunity to thank the members of the public who assisted with this incident. It because of the information provided by witnesses that this matter was able to be resolved so quickly.

January 27th, 2012

On January 27th, 2012 Police were called to a King Street East residence to assist Ambulance staff with a report of a suicidal male. Police attended with paramedics and as a result a 23 year old male was transported to KGH via ambulance for further assessment by medical staff.

January 28th, 2012

On January 28th, 2012 Police attended a Brock Street residence in regards to a complaint of a door being damaged. Upon arrival a subsequent investigation resulted in a 22 year old female being charged with one count of mischief under \$5000.00. The female was arrested and released to deal with the charges at a later court date.

January 29th, 2012

On January 29th, 2012 officers responded to a report of a break and enter at a west end business and the theft of a computer. The incident is under investigation.
