# MEDIA RELEASE

## **News items for the period between June 6<sup>th</sup> and June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

---

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 74 occurrences during the seven day period ending June 12th, 2011. This included 17 criminal occurrences, 5 motor vehicle collisions and 10 calls to 911 for assistance. Officers laid numerous charges under the Highway Traffic Act, three charges under the Liquor Licence Act, and one 72 hour licence suspension.

### **June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

On June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service arrested a 20 year old male on an outstanding warrant. The male was charged with breach probation and fail to attend court. The male was released on a promise to appear with a later court date.

### **June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

On the 8<sup>th</sup> June 2011 the Gananoque Police Service during a 30 minute period at the time of the severe thunder storm received forty five(45) 911 calls for service. The emergencies ranged from downed power lines, tree limbs blocking road ways and striking motor vehicles as well as multiple reports of possible fires.

### **June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

On June 11th, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service responded to a 911 call reporting an assault. An investigation was conducted, resulting in a 27 year old male being arrested and charged with two counts of assault. The male was released on an Undertaking with Conditions and a court date in the near future.

### **June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

On June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service received a call of a theft of a handbag from a local business. Officers conducted an investigation which resulted in a 15 year old female being arrested and charged with theft under and possession of property obtained by crime. The female was released on a Promise to Appear and an Undertaking with conditions, to attend court at a later date.
