MEDIA RELEASE

News items for the period between May 30th and June 5th, 2011

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 73 occurrences during the seven day period ending June 5th, 2011. This included 19 criminal occurrences, 2 motor vehicle collisions and 8 calls to 911 for assistance.

May 31st, 2011

On May 31st, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service responded to a report of threatening behavior at a west end residence. An investigation was conducted, resulting in a 16 year old male being arrested and charged with Utter Threat to Cause Death and Assault with a Weapon. The male was released on an Undertaking with Conditions and a court date in the near future.

June 4th, 2011

On June 4th, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service received a 911 call from a distraught female regarding being followed by a male party. Officers attended and arrested a 48 year old male for breach of the peace. Investigation revealed the male to be currently under court order. The male was subsequently charged with a Breach of Recognizance and Breach of Undertaking Before a Justice. The male was held in custody for a Show Cause Bail Hearing.
