News items for the period between April 4th and April 10th 2011

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 70 occurrences during the seven day period ending April 10th, 2011. This included 12 criminal occurrences, 1 motor vehicle collision, 7 calls to 911 for assistance and 2 Liquor Licence Act occurrences.

April 5th, 2011

On April 5th, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service received a report of a stolen 140' ship to shore power cable and adaptors. The cable and adaptors are valued between \$3,000 to \$5,000 dollars. It is believed the cable was stolen for copper wire content, estimated at 150 pounds.

The Gananoque Police dispatch system does not have call display and no one is required to identify themselves. The public can also call Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-8477. Information that is provided is confidential and you will not be required to identify yourself. Crime Stoppers pays a monetary reward for information that leads to an arrest of a suspect.

April 8th, 2011

On April 8th, 2011 officers of the Gananoque Police Service on routine patrol observed a vehicle with improper licence plates. Officers initiated traffic stop and the vehicle continued at a high rate of speed. Officers pursued and the vehicle was stopped a short distance later. A 19 year old male was arrested and charged with Dangerous Operation of a Motor Vehicle and Flight from Police. The male was released on a Promise to Appear with Undertaking and multiple conditions. The investigation is continuing.

April 8th, 2011

On April 8th, 2011 officers of the Gananoque Police Service received information that a 39 year old female was in breach of her Recognizance of Bail. An investigation was conducted resulting in the female being arrested and charged with 3 counts of Fail to Comply with Recognizance. The female was held in custody pending a Show Cause Bail Hearing.

April 10th, 2011

On April 10th, 2011 officers of the Gananoque Police Service conducted a traffic stop. Investigation resulted in a 37 year old Brockville male being arrested and charged with Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking in a Narcotic. Male was later released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking with a court date in the near future.
