News items for the period between April 17th and April 24th, 2011

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 54 occurrences during the seven day period ending April 24th, 2011. This included 14 criminal occurrences, 3 motor vehicle collisions, 20 calls to 911 for assistance and 7 Provincial Offence Notices issued.

April 18th, 2011

On Monday, April 18th, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service received a call from a local youth facility requesting police assistance with a resident of the facility. The youth was causing a disturbance in the residence and threatening to damage property. The youth was arrested under the Youth Criminal Justice Act and subsequently held for a Show Cause Hearing. The youth was later released by the court on a Recognizance of Bail with multiple conditions.

April 19th, 2011

On Tuesday, April 19th, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service and Emergency Services received numerous 911 calls for service regarding a motor vehicle that had crashed into the front window of a local business. The lone driver was not injured and no charges were laid. No one was injured as a result of the accident.

April 24th, 2011

In the early morning hours of April 24th, 2011 the Gananoque Police Service investigated a disturbance in the north end. As a result of the investigation police arrested and charged a 32 year old male with two counts of assault with a weapon and two counts of possession of a controlled substance. The male was released with conditions and will appear in court at a later date.
