News Items for the period between August 8th – August 14th, 2010

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 69 occurrences during the seven day period ending July 25th, 2010. This included 13 criminal occurrences, 8 motor vehicle accidents and 40 calls to 911 for assistance.

August 8th, 2010

On the 8th of August, 2010 officers of the Gananoque Police Service conducted a traffic stop resulting in a 30 year old male being arrested and charged with Impaired Operation and Over 80mgs. The male was issued a 90 day drivers license suspension and released on a promise to appear and is to appear in court at a later date.

August 14th, 2010

On the 14th of August, 2010 members of the Gananoque Police Service responded to multiple calls reporting a disturbance. Officers attended and spoke to all involved parties. One 26 year old male was arrested for a breach of the peace and later released unconditionally.

August 14th, 2010

On the 14th of August, 2010 members of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a report of a suspicious person outside a north end residence. Officers attended and located an intoxicated male. Further investigation resulted in the 35 year old being charged with 2 counts of Fail to Comply with Recognizance. Male was held in custody for a show cause bail hearing.

The Gananoque Police Service is currently investigating an incident involving the tampering with an Interac machine at a local business. The public is reminded to monitor bank and credit cards accounts periodically for any fraudulent activity.

The Gananoque Police Service would like to remind everyone the importance of being vigilant whenever children are playing near water of any kind. Parents and guardians are encouraged to visit the Gananoque Police Service websites “Kids Zone” at gananoquepoliceservice.com to learn more about water safety. Residents of Gananoque are also reminded that any pool with more than 2 feet of water must be enclosed with a fence and self closing gate.
