### **News Items for The Period between January 16<sup>th</sup> – January 23<sup>rd</sup> , 2011**

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 49 occurrences during the seven day period ending January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2011. This included 6 criminal occurrences, and 4 calls to 911 for assistance. Police also issued various Highway Traffic Act offences.

#### **January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

On January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2011 Gananoque Police Service and the OPP Drug Enforcement Unit executed a drug warrant which resulted in the arrest of a 31 year old male and a 24 year old male. Both males were charged with 2 counts of Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking and the 24 year old male was also charged with Possession of a Schedule II Substance and 3 counts of Fail to Comply with Undertaking. One male was held for bail and the other was later released on a Promise to Appear.

#### **January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2011**

On January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 members of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a call regarding threats. As a result an 18 year old male was arrested and charged with Uttering Threats to Cause Damage to Property and Uttering Threats to Cause Death. Male was later released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking before an Officer in Charge to appear in court at a later date.

#### **Snowmobiles**

Gananoque Police Service reminds everyone who operates a motorized snow vehicle within the Town of Gananoque that it is not permitted to operate a snow machine on a sidewalk, or on King Street between Victoria Ave and Herbert Street. A speed limit of not more than 25 km per hour must be maintained and snow machines shall not be operated between 11pm and 7am. Anyone found contravening this by-law is liable to a fine of not more than \$1000.00 upon conviction.
