News Items for the period between July 19th and July 25th, 2010

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 90 occurrences during the seven day period ending July 25th, 2010. This included 18 criminal occurrences, 3 motor vehicle accidents and 62 calls to 911 for assistance.

July 20th, 2010

On the 20th of July, 2010 members of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a report of an assault. An investigation was conducted resulting in a 17 year old male being arrested and charged with assault causing bodily harm. Male was released on a promise to appear and an undertaking before an officer in charge to appear in court at a later date.

July 20th, 2010

On the 20th of July, 2010 members of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a call for assistance at the waterfront. A 62 year old male was arrested and charged with Operating a Vessel with Over 80mgs. The male was issued a 90 day drivers license suspension and released on a promise to appear and is to appear in court at a later date.

July 22nd, 2010

On the 22nd of July, 2010 members of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a 911 call for assistance for a disturbance. An investigation was conducted and as a result, a 53 year old male was arrested for Utter Threat to Cause Bodily Harm. Male was later released on promise to appear and undertaking before an officer in charge to appear in court at a later date.

July 23rd, 2010

On the 9th of July, 2010, members of the Gananoque Police Service received a report of a fight in front of a King Street business. An investigation was conducted resulting in a 38 year old being arrested and charged with failing to comply with undertaking before an officer in charge. Male was released on promise to appear and undertaking before an officer in charge to appear in court at a later date.
