MEDIA RELEASE

News items for the period between July 24th and July 31, 2011.

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 93 occurrences during the seven day period ending July 24, 2011. This included 12 Theft occurrences, 4 Motor vehicle collisions and 2 Drug charges. There were also numerous Provincial Offence Notices issued and a number of cautions.

On July 25th 2011 officers responded for assistance with a call of a family dispute. Upon arrival officers apprehended one female under the Mental Health Act for her own safety. Female was taken to the Brockville General Hospital for assessment and later released into the care of a family member.

On July 27th 2011 officers of the Gananoque Police service responded to a theft of a boat motor on Oak Street. Motor is of Evinrude make, 1987 and dark blue in colour with red lettering. No suspects at this time.

On July 28th 2011 officers responded to a call regarding a patron causing problems at a local inn. A female was located, exhibiting signs of intoxication as well as behavior that led to her apprehension under the Mental Health Act. Female was transported to the Brockville General Hospital for assessment and later charged with two counts of Assault on a Peace Officer. Female was released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking, to appear in court at a later date.

On July 28th 2011 while on patrol, officers of the Gananoque Police Service located a male exhibiting behavior leading to his apprehension under the Mental Health Act. Male was identified as missing from a Kingston mental health care centre and male was apprehended and returned to the facility.

On July 29th 2011 the Gananoque Police Service received ten 911 calls to attend King Street East in relation to a physical altercation involving 4 males. Several reports were received of a male brandishing a knife during the incident. Officers attended resulting in 4 males being arrested ranging from ages 21 to 32. Officers laid five Criminal Code Charges against the males as a result on the incident, including Cause Disturbance By Fighting, Possession of a Weapons Dangerous and Assault with a Weapon. One offence under Controlled Drug and Substance Act charge was laid for

Possession of a Controlled Substance. One male was also arrested in relation to outstanding Warrants. All persons to appear in court at a later date.

On July 29th 2011 officers of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a call of a Motor vehicle accident at the corner of King St. at Charles St involving a transport and a vehicle. There were no serious injuries.

On July 30th 2011 officers responded to a call of a male wielding a 2x4. As a result a 36 year old male was arrested for being intoxicated in a public place. Further investigation led to the male being charged with Unauthorized Possession of a Weapon, Possession of Firearm Etc. while Prohibited and Breach of Probation. The male was released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking to appear in court at a later date.

On July 30th 2011 officers responded to a call of a person pulling up flowers and tipping mailboxes. As a result a female was arrested and charged with two counts of Mischief Under \$5000 and one count of Possession of Marihuana. Female was released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking to appear in court at a later date.
