MEDIA RELEASE

News items for the period between May 9th and May 15th 2011

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 57 occurrences during the seven day period ending May 15th, 2011. This included 14 criminal occurrences, 1 motor vehicle collision, 4 calls to 911 for assistance and 6 Provincial Offence Notices were issued.

May 11th, 2011

Officers of the Drug Enforcement Unit – Project Islander conducted a Controlled Drugs and Substances Act search warrant at a residence on Old River Road, Rockport. A 57 year old male was charged with Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking and held for a bail hearing.

Officers seized 1617 marihuana plants and 576 grams of packaged marihuana with an estimated street value of over 1.6 million dollars. Also seized was an undisclosed amount of Canadian and United States currency.

May 14th, 2011

Officers while on patrol were advised of a disturbance in Coopers Alley. An investigation was conducted resulting in a 31 year old male being charged with Being Intoxicated in a Public Place. Male was transported to station and held until sober.

May 15th, 2011

Officers while on patrol conducted on a routine traffic stop on vehicle that was observed failing to stop at a stop sign. During the traffic stop, officer detected an odour of alcohol from the driver. The driver provided a sample of his breath which registered a warn on the Roadside Screening Device. The 20 year old male driver was subsequently issued a 3 day suspension.
