Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 45 occurrences during the seven day period ending November 13th, 2011. This included 9 criminal occurrences, 2 motor vehicle collision, 4 calls to 911 for assistance and multiple Provincial Offense Notices.

November 7th, 2011

Officers responded to a 911 call for a motor vehicle collision on King Street East. One driver was charged with follow too closely and failing to surrender insurance card. No injuries were reported.

November 10th, 2011

The Gananoque Police Service received information a young male making threats. An investigation was conducted resulting in a 15 year old male being arrested and charged with uttering threats and weapons offences. The male was held in custody for a show cause bail hearing.

November 11th, 2011

The Gananoque Police Service received a report of a local resident receiving calls from a company claiming to be Microsoft Computer Company/Windows. This business is believed to be fraudulent, having no credentials that link them to Microsoft/Windows and have reportedly contacted numerous local residents in attempts to gain access to their personal information via their computers. Gananoque residents are reminded to use caution when receiving calls for computer services when they have not been requested.

November 12th, 2011

The Gananoque Police Service received a call from a female reporting she was assaulted while walking home from a King Street business. The female did not receive any injuries and the investigation is ongoing.

November 13th, 2011

Officers responded to report of a female at a downtown establishment that was breaching her release conditions. An investigation was conducted resulting in a 19 year old female being arrested and charged with 2 counts of failing to comply with undertaking. The female was released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking with conditions and will appear in court later this month.

The Gananoque Police Service would like to remind citizens that **Winter Parking** begins November 15th, 2011 and runs until April 1st, 2011. No vehicles may be parked on the street between the hours of 1 a.m. and 7 a.m.. Vehicles left on the street may be ticketed and may also be towed if they are interfering with snow removal.
