Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 66 occurrences during the seven day period ending October 9th, 2011. This included 15 criminal occurrences, 4 motor vehicle collision, 8 calls to 911 for assistance and 1 Mental Health occurrence.

October 3rd, 2011

Officers responded to a report of mischief to heavy construction equipment at an east end location. The investigation determined that several rocks had been thrown through various windows of the equipment causing in excess of \$1,000.00 damage.

October 4th, 2011

Officers responded to a complaint of an unwanted male at a Garden Street address. An investigation was conducted resulting in a 45 year old male being arrested and charged with Mischief Under \$5,000. The male was released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking Before an Officer in Charge with multiple conditions. Male will appear in court in the near future to answer to the charge.

October 5th, 2011

Officers responded to a call of a distraught emotional female at a King Street address. As a result a 48 year old female was transported to Kingston General Hospital for further assessment.

October 5th, 2011

Officers received a complaint of a mischief to a vehicle in which sugar was poured into the vehicle's gas tank. As a result of an investigation an 18 year old female was arrested and charged with Mischief Under \$5000 and Trespass by Night. Female was released on a promise to Appear and Undertaking to appear in court at a later date.

October 7th, 2011

Officers responded to a 911 call of a domestic at a King Street address. A 48 year old female was arrested for breach of the peace and held in custody for the night until sober. No charges were laid.

October 8th, 2011

Officers are investigating a break and enter which occurred at a Birch Street address in the late

afternoon/early evening hours. Suspects were heard leaving the residence upon the return home of a family member. Anyone having information about this incident is asked to call Gananoque Police Service or Crimestoppers.

October 9th, 2011

Officers responded to a call at the intersection of King and Stone Streets of an injured male in the early morning hours of October 9th. EMS was also contacted to assess the male who had suffered injuries to his face and head. Injuries were the result of a fight which occurred earlier in the area. Officers are continuing their investigation. Anyone with information concerning this incident is asked to contact Gananoque Police Service or Crimestoppers.

The Gananoque Police Service has received several complaints regarding a male approaching residences and requesting to enter the residence to check the home owner's hot water tank. No information has been obtained that would assist the police in identifying this male. Residents are reminded that any solicitors are required to carry identification on themselves and their company. Residents should be cautious of allowing any stranger enter their residence.
