### **GANANOQUE POLICE SERVICE CHARGED STUDENT WITH UTTERING DEATH THREATS**

On January 25, 2010 as a result of an ongoing investigation, the Gananoque Police charged a 14 year old grade 9 student from Gananoque Secondary School with additional criminal charges. The young person has been charged with 22 counts of uttering threats to cause death and failing to comply with the conditions of his undertaking. The police are continuing their investigation. The young person cannot be named under provisions of the Youth Criminal Justice Act.

On January 21, 2010 as the result of an ongoing police investigation and additional information received from the Gananoque Secondary School, the Gananoque Police Service arrested and charged a 14 year old grade 9 student with uttering threats to cause death and failing to comply with the conditions of his undertaking. The young person was detained in custody for a show cause hearing. The young person cannot be named under provisions of the Youth Criminal Justice Act.

The police and school officials have met with students and their parents to notify them of the situation.

The Gananoque Police Service are continuing their investigation and further charges may be laid.

We take any threats that would compromise student or school safety seriously and encourage anyone with information pertaining to this or other incidents to contact the Gananoque Police Service.
