Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 58 occurrences during the seven day period ending September 11th, 2011. This included 14 criminal occurrences, 4 motor vehicle collisions, 6 calls to 911 for assistance and 5 charges under the Highway Traffic Act.

September 5th, 2011

On September 5th 2011, officers of the Gananoque Police Service conducted a traffic stop on Garden Street resulting in the arrest of a male passenger for an outstanding arrest warrant. The 17 year old male was transported to the station where he was released on a Promise to Appear and an Undertaking before an Officer in Charge. Young male will appear in court at a later date.

September 6th, 2011

On September 6th 2011, officers responded to information of bones found in a yard of a Garden Street residence. Officers found 4 large bones and 16 smaller bones under the soil's surface. Findings were sent to the pathologist for investigation and it was found that the bones were approximately 50 years old and are non-human, most likely cow or pig. Further findings will be directed to pathologists for future investigation.

September 8th, 2011

On September 8th 2011, a male attended the Gananoque Police Station to report being struck by a vehicle on September 6th, 2011 while walking Westbound on King Street East as the vehicle turned North on Stone Street. Male reports suffering back injuries due to being struck. Suspect is described as Caucasian, female, approximately 19 years old with dirty blonde hair, driving a black medium-sized vehicle. September 8th, 2011

On September 8th, 2011 Officers received a report of mischief to a local public school. Graffiti was located on the outer wall of the school, in an oil based paint. September 8th, 2011

On September 8th, 2011 Officers of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a call of a domestic dispute on a King Street address. Upon investigation, a 48 year old female was arrested and charged with Assault, Assault with a Weapon, Assault a Peace Officer, Utter Threat to Cause Death and Breach of Probation. Female was held in custody for a bail hearing.

September 8th, 2011

On September 8th 2011 Officers of the Gananoque Police Service received information regarding a male driving from Brockville to Gananoque who may be intoxicated. Officers stopped vehicle, where it was determined that the driver had not consumed any alcohol.

September 11th, 2011

On September 11th, 2011 Officers received a report of a theft that occurred at a King Street business. Suspect information was forwarded to the Kingston Police Service, where suspect was believed to be living. The Kingston Police Service arrested and transported suspect to the Gananoque Police Service where the 33 year old male was charged with Theft Under \$5000 and released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking before an Officer in Charge. Male will appear in court at a later date.
