Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 91 occurrences during the seven day period ending September 4th, 2011. This included 18 criminal occurrences, 5 motor vehicle collisions, 12 calls to 911 for assistance. There were several charges under the Highway Traffic Act.

On August 29, 2011 Gananoque Police received a call from a west end business regarding problems with a patron in the store who was being verbally abusive to staff. Police later located the male and he was cautioned for his behavior and served a trespass notice to no longer attend the business.

On August 29th, 2011 Police were called to attend at a residence on Brock Street to stand by while Union Gas workers investigated a gas leak. As a result of what workers located a criminal investigation into theft of gas service was initiated and is ongoing at this time.

On August 29th, 2011 Police received a call about a domestic disturbance at a King Street apartment. Police attended and an investigation revealed that a 17 year old male had damaged the wall and door of an apartment in the building and fled prior to police arrival. As a result the male was not located and a warrant was issued for his arrest on charges of mischief and breaching the conditions of a YCJA probation order.

On August 30th, 2011 Police responded to a call about a possible impaired driver. Officers located the driver who was found to be sober and was cautioned as to his driving. The Gananoque Police would like to remind the public that if they suspect a person is impaired while driving they can call 911 to report the incident to police. Police welcome the public's assistance in the fight against drinking and driving.

On August 30th, 2011 Police responded to a 911 call regarding a break and enter in progress at a Gananoque residence. Unknown persons attempted to break into a residence through a kitchen window while the occupants of the house were still home. The suspect was not able to gain entry into the residence and fled the scene prior to police arrival and has not been located. Investigation is continuing.

On September 1st, 2011 Police received a call from an east end business regarding an intoxicated male on the premises. As a result police attended and arrested a 24 year old male for public intoxication and transported him to station where he was held until sober and released after being served a provincial offences notice under the Liquor License Act.

On September 4th, 2011 An officer while on patrol observed a fight in front of a King Street business. As a result of an investigation a 40 year old male was arrested under the Liquor

Licence Act for being intoxicated in a public place. The male was held until sober and released after being served a provincial offences notice under the Liquor Licence Act.
