News Items for the period between December 12th - December 19th, 2010

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 48 occurrences during the seven day period ending December 19th, 2010. This included 12 criminal occurrences, 1 motor vehicle accident and responded to 2 911 calls for assistance.

As we are entering the holiday season Gananoque Police Officers will be conducting R.I.D.E programs throughout the Town of Gananoque. Please remember to drink responsibly and Don't Drink and Drive.

And a reminder now that the snow has started to fall, the Town Bylaw for Winter Parking is in effect from November 15th until April 1st. There is no street parking between the hours of 1am and 7am, this is to allow snow removal.

Gananoque Police Service would like to remind citizens that under the Ontario Tobacco Tax Act it is illegal to sell or possess contraband tobacco products without the proper vendor's permits or other documentation authorizing a person to sell or possess such products.
