### NEWS RELEASE

#### News Items for the period between January 2 - January 8, 2011

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 45 occurrences during the seven day period ending January 8, 2011. This included 6 criminal occurrences, 3 motor vehicle accident and responding to 1 call to 911 for assistance. Police also issued Provincial Offences Notice for Liquor Licence Act infractions and various Highway Traffic Act Offences.

#### January 2, 2011

On January 2, 2011 as a result of a traffic stop 3 males age 27, and 2 20 year olds and 1 female age 19 yrs were arrested and charged for possession for the purpose of trafficking a controlled substance. One male was held in custody for a bail hearing. All other parties were released on a Promise to Appear and an Undertaking Before Officer in Charge.

#### January 5, 2011

On January 5, 2011 members of the Gananoque Police Service responded to a call in regard to an assault. As a result a 19 year old male was arrested and charged with 2 counts of Assault, Assault with a Weapon, Breach of Probation, Possession of Weapon for Dangerous Purpose and Carrying a Concealed Weapon. Male was held in custody for a bail hearing. Warrants have been issued for 2 other males involved in the incident.

Gananoque Police Service reminds everyone who operates a motorized snow vehicle within the Town of Gananoque is not permitted to operate the snow machine on a sidewalk, or on King St. between Victoria Ave and Herbert St. They must maintain a speed limit of not more than 25km per hr and shall not operate the machine between 11pm and 7am. Anyone found contravening this by-law is liable to upon conviction of a fine of not more than \$1000.00.
