MEDIA RELEASE

News items for the period between November 21st and November 27th, 2011

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service investigated 50 occurrences during the seven day period ending November 27th, 2011. This included 17 criminal occurrences, 6 motor vehicle collisions, 5 calls to 911 for assistance and 1 Provincial Offence Notice issued.

November 25th, 2011

Officers responded to a call of a shoplifter observed in a King Street business. The male left the business prior to police arrival. Officers located male a short time later at a Garden Street address. The 20 year old male was arrested and charged with Theft Under and Possession of Property obtained by crime. Male was released on a promise to Appear and Undertaking to appear in court at a later date.

November 25th, 2011

Officers were advised of a theft of a bicycle from a local area school. Bike is described as a white and red Blaster BMX bike. Anyone with information regarding this bike is asked to contact Gananoque Police Service.

November 25th, 2011

Officer conducted a routine traffic stop on a vehicle and upon investigation an amount of cocaine was found on the male driver. As a result a 50 year old male was arrested and charged with Possession of Cocaine. Male was released on a Promise to Appear and Undertaking to appear in court at a later date.

November 27th, 2011

On November 27th, 2011 Officers of the Gananoque Police Service received information regarding a female youth breaching the conditions of her Undertaking before an Officer in Charge. Officers arrested the 16 year old female for two counts of Fail to Comply with Undertaking. Female was later released on a Promise to Appear, Notice to Parent and Undertaking before an Officer in Charge.

RIDE

Officers from the Gananoque Police Service conducted RIDE over the November 24-25th weekend. Officers checked over 600 vehicles, issued 25 cautions under the Highway Traffic Act and 2 cautions under the Liquor Licence Act.
